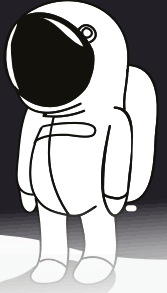

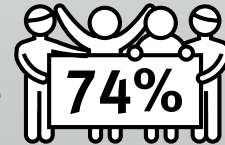

said their views were fully or partially included



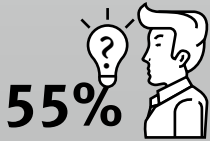

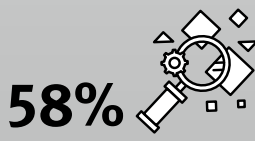

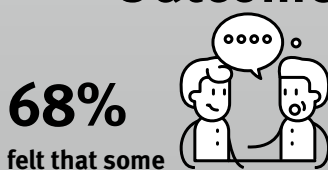

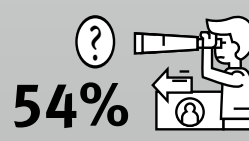

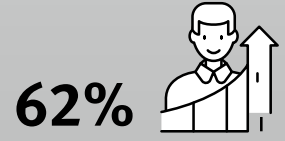

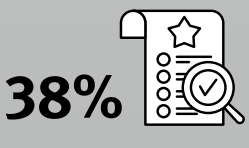

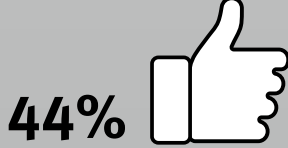

How do children and young people rate the way their support helps them to...?



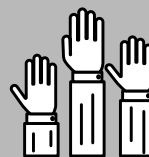
...be part of the local community?
